I. Read and translate the following text and put five types of questions to the underlined fragment.

Board meetings are attended by the directors of the company. Day to day business decisions are usually taken at board meetings. Matters to be decided upon are put to the meeting in the form of 'resolutions', each director present casting a vote for or against each resolution being considered. (Voting is usually by a 'show of hands'.) Whether or not a resolution is passed depends on whether the majority of votes are in favour of or against that resolution. In other words the decision is made by a simple majority. Multi-national companies with directors located internationally often stipulate in their articles that board meetings may be validly held by means of telephone or audio-visual conferencing as well as via the internet. Any director can call a board meeting on reasonable notice to all the other directors.
