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
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
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CONTENT

This academic discipline is a theoretical and practical basis of the totality of knowledge and skills that form the professional level of a lawyer in the system of legal education. is developed on the basis of "Methodical instructions for the development and execution of training and work syllabus of disciplines", put into effect by the order of 16.06.2015. №37 / pp.

One of the necessary conditions for the organization of the educational process for the credit-module system is the availability of a working curriculum for each discipline developed according to modular-rating principles and brought to the attention of teachers and students.

The rating system of evaluation (RCE) is an integral part of the work curriculum and involves determining the quality of the student's performance of all types of classroom and individual learning activities and the level of knowledge and skills acquired by evaluating the results of this work in the balls during the current, modular and semester control, with the subsequent transfer of the assessment on a multi-scale scale to the national scale and ECTS scale.

The RSE provides for the use of modular rating assessments (current, control, summary), as well as examination or accounting, final semester and total ratings.

2. 2 Homework
