EPILOGUE

At the end of the work we would like to mark out the following. The authors understand that the considered model is an imperfect one. Moreover, how much this English version is more or less perfect compared with the Russian version of the monograph "Light and Shadow" [XXXII] published in 2013 is up to the readers. Nonetheless, the principle developed to describe active systems behavior turns out to be prolific in application to multi-alternative economical problems.

Some prospective development directions of the model, in our opinion, are closed economical cycles and dynamical framework of theoretical research. The simplified consideration of such problem contained in the presented monograph does not take into account those important factors.

In regards to the variety of the possible applicable scientific spheres, we would like to highlight again that apparently the **SUBJECTIVE ENTROPY MAXIMUM PRINCIPLE** has not exhausted its powerful potential yet. Therefore, the authors would encourage the theoreticians of other fields of research do not quit studying and investigating their areas through the promising prism of the proposed entropy paradigm.
