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1. INTRODUCTION

Course training program of the discipline is developed on the basis of the curriculum of the discipline "Fundamentals of Roman private law" and "Methodological guidelines for the development and implementation of training and work syllabus of disciplines", put into operation by the order dated 16.06.15? 37 / roses.


The rating system of evaluation (RCO) is an integral part of the work curriculum and involves determining the quality of the student's performance of all types of classroom and individual learning activities and the level of knowledge and skills acquired by evaluating the results of this work in the balls during the current, modular and semester control, with the subsequent transfer of the assessment on a multi-scale scale to the national scale and ECTS scale.

4.7. The Semester Module Grade and the Test Grade together make up a Total Semester Grade, which is expressed in values according to the National Scale and the ECTS Scale (Table 4.6).

4.7. The Total Semester Grade in values by National System Grades and ECTS Scale is input into the Examination Register, Academic Student Card and into a Student’s Record Book.

4.8. The Total Semester Grade is input into a student’s record book, for example: **92/Ex/A**, **87/Good/B**, **79/Good/C**, **68/Sat/D**, **65/Sat./E**, etc.

4.9. The Total Semester Grade is equal to Total Semester Grade. Mentioned Total Semester Grade on subject is entered into Annex of Diploma Paper.
